Pat James reported on the Advent Booklet which will be mailed out in November. Joyce Seng will take of ordering the candles for the Advent wreath. White bags will be used for the Luminaries.

The church has a need to initiate a disaster plan in case of a fire.

Implementation of the GIRM is as follows:

There should be no quiet masses on Sundays or Holy Days. Lectors will carry the Book of the Gospels and placed on the Altar, This will start after Christmas, EM to consume all the wine at the Credence Table. Those receiving Communion shall bow their head out of reverence whenever receiving communion.
