

# LITURGY TEAM REPORT

## 2 November 2003

### Minutes:

- Mary Galuardi will be the representative from Liturgies With Children since Lynne Johnson is moving to Florida.
- Liturgy Ordo
  - Nov. 8-9: There will be a Rite of Acceptance and Welcome for RCIA at the 10 am mass. The Sodality will induct new members at the 5:30 pm mass. Since it is the Dedication of St. John Lateran Basilica in Rome, there will be a Sprinkling Rite instead of the Penitential Rite (ties in with the reading).
  - It was discussed commissioning new liturgical ministers on the Baptism of the Lord. Holly will check to see if there are any conflicts.
  - It was corrected that mass Christmas morning is at 8 am.
- Report from Night with William Cochran
  - Joyce reported that it was a successful evening with about 25 people in attendance.
  - It was stressed that art would not overtake the church.
  - Art & Environment will meet and talk about things that might take place once the Master Plan is completed, order projects (if at all) and talk about the possibilities.
- Update on Parish Mission
  - Fr. Joe Breighner has been booked for March 27-30. He will speak at all masses and the three evenings. His fee is \$1200. It was noted that this is a weekend of a Liturgy With Children. That will be moved and Mary Galuardi will notify Ken Lenta.
- Advent Report
  - The theme will be the Magnificat.
  - Each week purple (or pink) streamers will be added to a lightpost on the driveway along with a sign with one word describing the theme of that particular week. Fr. John is investigating the signs. Joyce is working on the streamers. Paul suggested handing out magnets with the Magnificat and an explanation of it on the magnet for the first week of Advent.
  - Pat will incorporate this in the November Liturgy Corner for the bulletin.
  - Holly will be putting together a newsletter for Advent.
  - The focus inside the church will be the Advent Wreath and therefore, that will be the only decoration.

- Reports from various ministries
  - Eucharistic Minister Training will finish by 11/9 with 10 new being added.
  - Lectors added 5 new ministers and Peter Heisler's name was passed on to John Jaffee.
  - The Liturgies With Children committee has new members and new family members. They are also try to reach out to the deaf community and those liturgies will now be interpreted for the deaf community.
  - CLOW was expanded to the noon mass 11/2/03.
  - Art and Environment is looking into obtaining an ambry (for the oils) for the church.
- Holly noted that members need to nourish their own spirituality if we are to nourish the spirituality of the parish. She distributed Little Blue Books to help provide reflection material for committee members during Advent.
